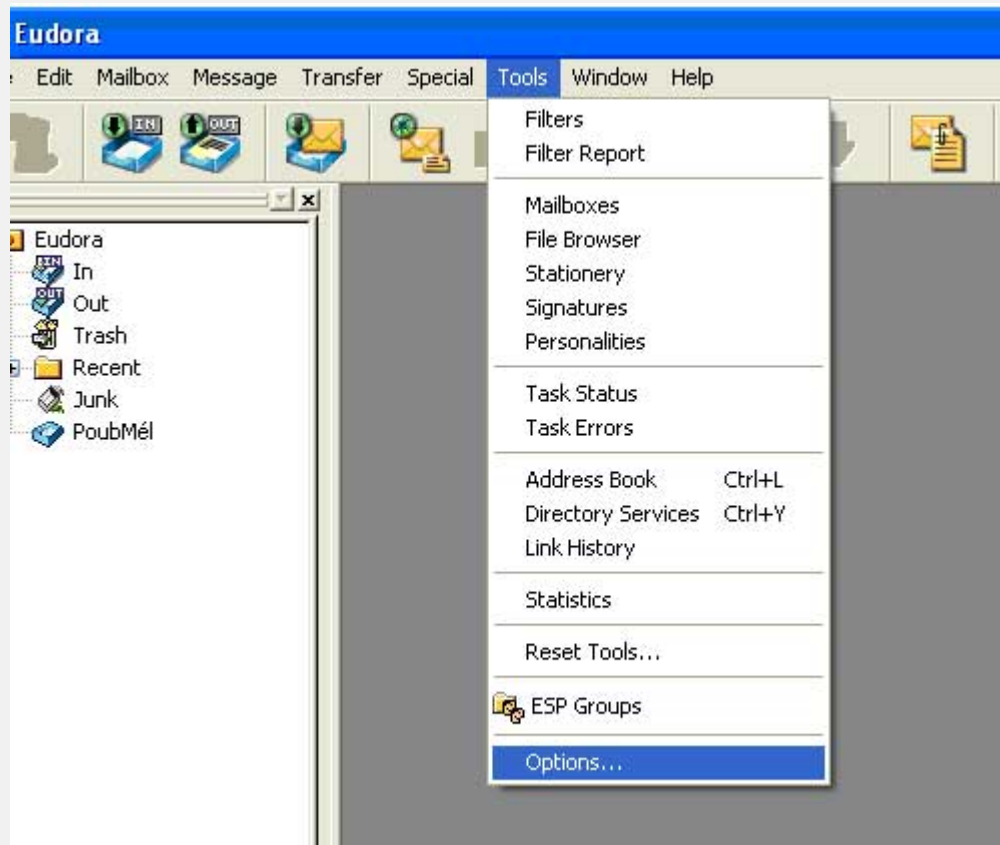

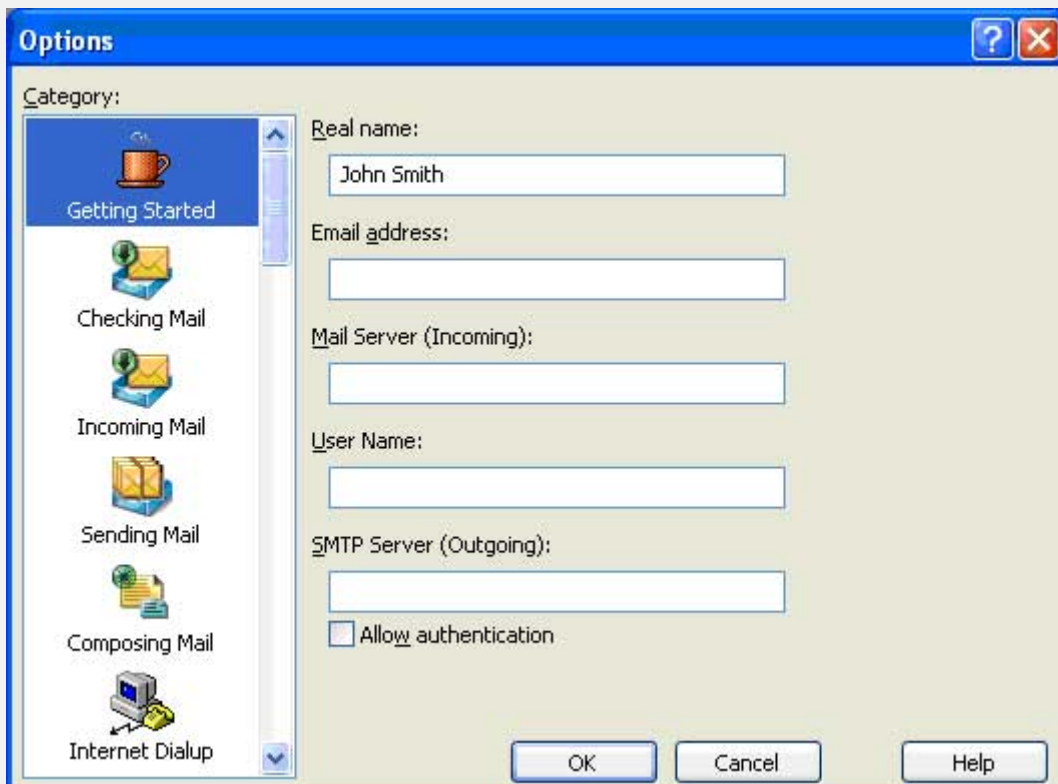
1) Go to the **Tools** menu and select **Options**.

For example johnsmith@xplornet.com.

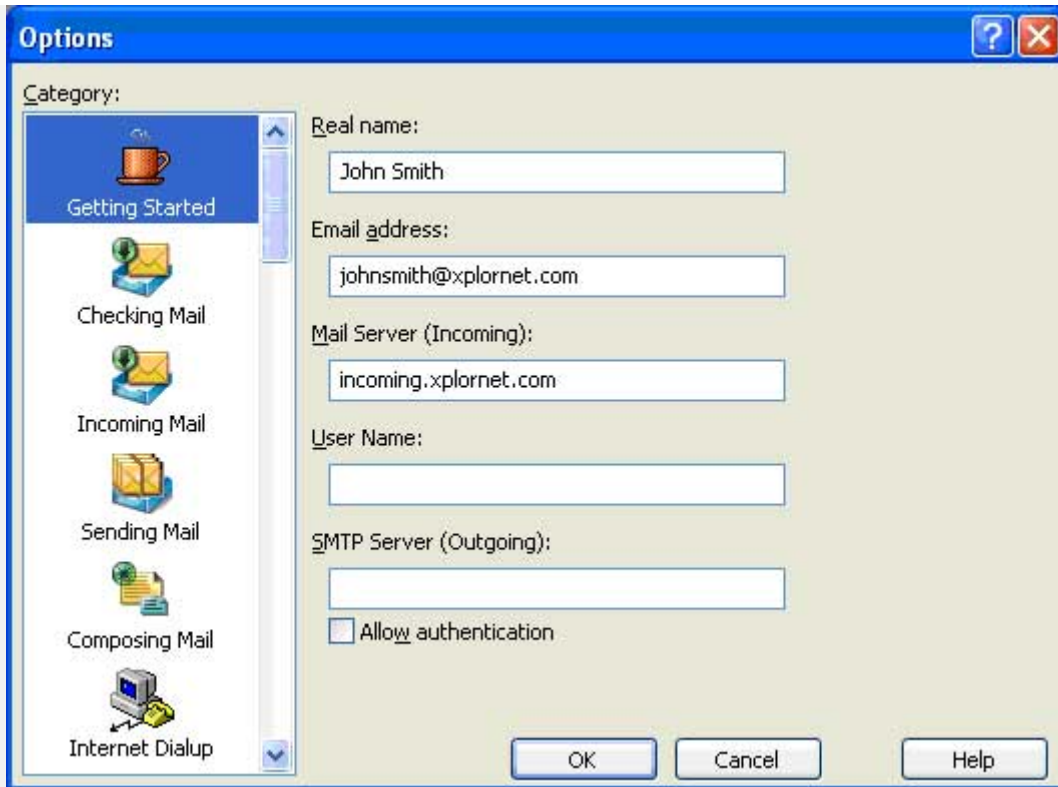

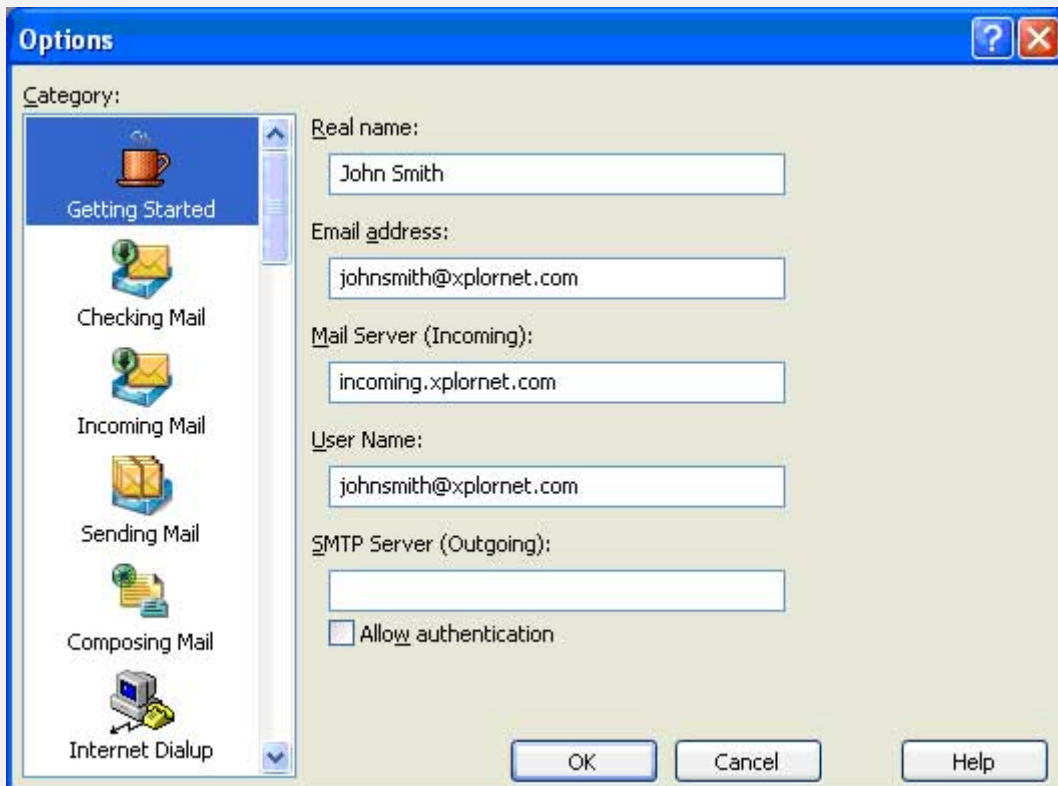


- 5) In the **Mail Service (Incoming)** field, enter **incoming.xplornet.com**.



6) In the **User Name** field, enter your complete email address including @xplornet.com.



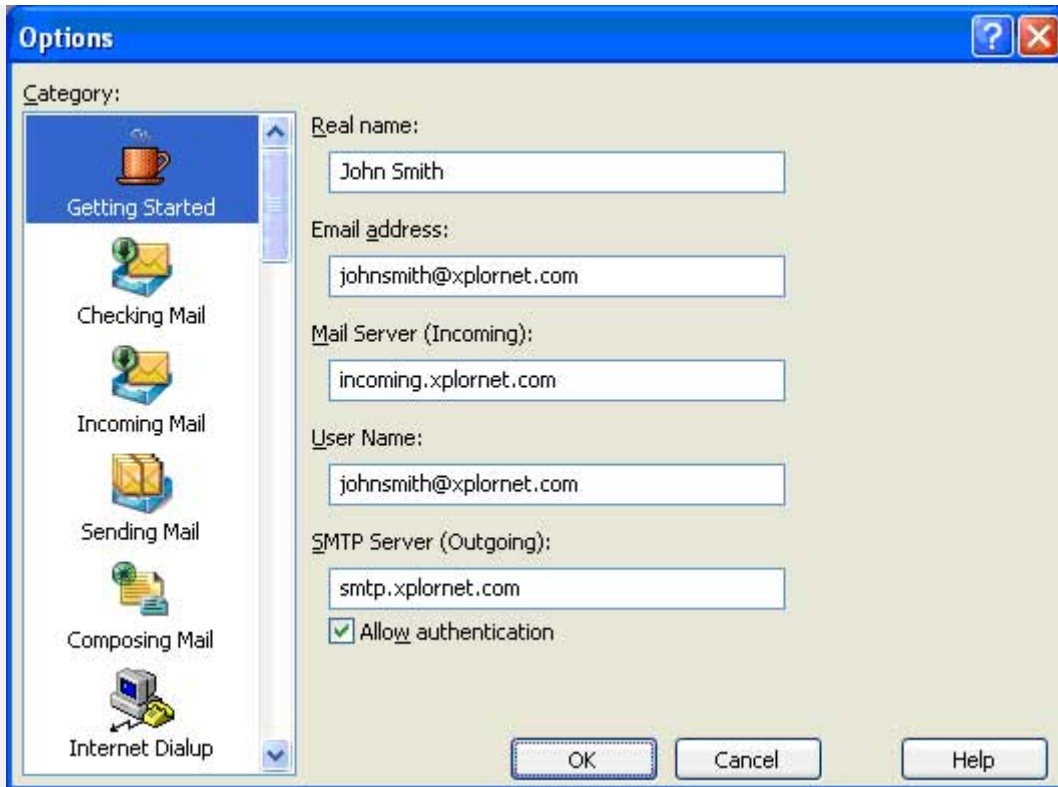
7) In the **SMTP Service (Outgoing)** field, enter **smtp.xplornet.com**.
